Stakeholder Feedback Report on Curriculum 2021-22

The feedback mechanism is well established in the institution. Every year IQAC takes initiatives to collect feedback on curriculum from students. IQAC has designed a Google form with five questions as mentioned below. The link is shared with students through Head of Department with proper notification. After collection of feedback from the students, the excel sheet generated from student response is shared with concerned head of department. The departments organize a meeting and discuss over students' feedback. Some of the departments collect feedback from students on their own which are brought to discussion in the meeting. Finally, the departments draft analysis report for the discussion in BOS meeting. In BOS meeting students' feedback on curriculum is considered for discussion, and if required relevant changes are made in syllabus with consensus of all members. ATR (Action Taken Report) is prepared by individual departments and submitted to IQAC. The reports of individual department are considered for discussion in Planning and Evaluation Committee, Academic council.

Questionaries for feedback on curriculum.

- Q1. Do you feel that the present syllabus is up to the mark?
- Q2. Do you expect any changes in the present syllabus?
- Q3. Are you satisfied with the present course you have selected?
- Q4. Do you get the practical knowledge from the present syllabus?
- Q5. Any other suggestion.

Objectives of taking feedback on curriculum.

Stake holders' participation is important for any kind of development. The feedback collection, analysis and inculcation in to the curriculum is gradual process of evolution. Any development should be demand driven blended with the existing resources available and new resources to be generated. Therefore, students' feedback on syllabus becomes very important source to know what the student wants to study, what he wants to learn, how he wants to understand the concept, how to make the syllabus easy graspable, how to know whether the students can achieve the expected outcome.

Department wise Feedback Analysis Report and Action Taken Report Department of Marathi

On behalf of the Marathi Department, the feedback form was filled online by the students of BA Part 1/2/3. A total of 68 students, 45 of BA Part 1, 13 of BA Part 2 and 10 of BA Part 3 registered their votes. In the feedback form, students were asked four questions related to the syllabus. The first question in that was whether your current coursework is sufficient for grading. 93.33% of BA Part 1 students, 92.31% of BA Part 2 and 90% of BA Part 3 students answered yes to it. In the second question, do you want to change the course ? 37.78% of BA Part 1 students, 46.15% of BA Part 2 and 50% of BA Part 3 students gave some suggestions. Which was considered in the study board meeting. His separate report is given below. 91.11% of BA Part 1 students, 84.62% of BA Part 2 and 80% of BA Part 3 students expressed their satisfaction when asked the third question "Are you satisfied with the course?" The fourth question asked whether there are skill-based components in the curriculum. It was answered by 73.33% of BA Part 1 students, 84.62% of BA Part 2 and 60% of BA Part 3 students.

According to the overall curriculum feedback, an average of 93% students expressed satisfaction with the curriculum. Marathi curriculum will be helpful to give them sufficient knowledge and skills. Such a conclusion can be drawn. An attempt has been made to give scope to the talents of the students. Hence Marathi curriculum becomes important.

Action Taken Report

According to the feedback report, the students had given some suggestions regarding the syllabus. In this regard, the action taken on behalf of the department is as follows.

- 1. The suggestions of the students were placed before the Board of Marathi Studies for action. Expert guides reviewed the instructions of the students. Members recorded their reactions to these suggestions.
- 2. Marathi Syllabus includes topics in student instruction. However, the suggestion to expand it was accepted. According to the suggestions of the students, it was decided to change the syllabus for the following years.

Overall, according to the feedback report, action was taken in the course as above.

Analysis

- The information in the above table is based on the report of the Feedback of the students from BA- I, II, III. Depending on the information in the table the following analysis is done and conclusions drawn-
- Totally 60 students from Arts Faculty responded. (Nineteen students from First Year, twenty-three from Second Year and eighteen from Third Year) Thus the percentage of the students responding is very less compared to the
- total strength of the students.
- Out of the students who responded, 88% of the students feel that the present syllabus is up to the mark.
- 55% of the respondents expect changes in the present syllabus
- 93% respondents are satisfied with the course they have chosen.

• 28% respondents think that they do not get practical knowledge from the present syllabus.

Conclusion

- Looking at the scanty number of the respondents, one can say that either the students didn't get information about the feedback system or they were not interested.
- More than three fourth of the respondents are happy with the syllabus as it is up to the mark.
- Majority of the respondents are satisfied with their decision of selecting the course
 yet a small portion of the respondents pointed out to the fact of not gaining practical
 knowledge through the syllabus.

- Out of the total 651 respondents only 500 students have responded to the question and the remaining 151 students have abstained from answering


Action taken:



The Department of Commerce solicited input on the curriculum from UG students in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the College. Total 90 UG students from BCOM I, II and III provided input.

Below is a summary of the aforementioned feedback:

1.83% of undergraduate student respondents agreed that the current curriculum is adequate in terms of career planning.

They believed that courses like marketing, accounting, insurance, and cooperation have enhanced their chances of finding employment.

The students also stated that studying subjects like Entrepreneurship Development has inspired them to pursue entrepreneurship as a career.

- 2.According to 65% of the respondents, the current syllabus is fine and doesn't need to be changed. According to 35% of the students, the syllabus has to be updated by becoming more practically focused.
- 3. Eighty-seven percent of the students who have provided the feedback said they were satisfied with the course they have selected.
- 4. Additionally, the students thought the exam should include multiple-choice questions.





Very few students have suggested that the theory course should be practical or industrial application oriented, theory syllabus should be advanced and include points from NET, SET and GATE exam.


Action Taken Report:

Students feedback plays a remarkable role in Curriculum Design and Development by providing useful insights for upgrading various aspects of teaching and learning. Collecting feedback from the students is most important for the success of every institution. Detailed analysis of feedback responses from all stakeholders are discussed below.

While only 20% students expect some changes in the syllabus. 100% students express their satisfaction and 80% students report that they get practical knowledge from the syllabus that they have learnt.

Among total students responded (3), nearly 80% B.Sc.-III Electronics students have given their opinion as the syllabus taught to them is up to the mark which means that the syllabus meets their expectations or requirements. While 80% students expect some changes in the syllabus. About 100% students express their satisfaction and they get practical knowledge from the syllabus that they have learnt.

- Students have also requested to organize industrial visits for practical approach.






