

## **Institutional Social Responsibility**

The institution is surrounded by Academic institutions, NGOs, GOs, media, slums and the rural area. The network with the community is developed through NSS and NCC activities, faculty expertise, MOUs and the social activities.

The learners are provided to have firsthand experience of the society and its problems. They are sensitized towards these problems so that they will be responsible citizens and serve the same society in their career. The emotional, intellectual and social faculties of the learners are developed through these extension activities. The institution reaches the society, studies its problems and presents it to the public through the publication College Annual Magazine, Newspapers and College Research Journal. The survey of school deprived children is conducted by NSS. Around 32 students participated in this program.

There is a mechanism of keeping record of active students in extracurricular activities. The NSS program officers, NCC officers, departments promote the active participants in the social movement like Eco Ganesh Festival, Traffic control, Swatchhta Abhiyan, Jalyukta Shiwar Abhiyan, Save water, Health Awareness, Women Empowerment, Soil Conservation, Ttree Plantation, Anti Corruption. The Management and the Staff donated fifty lakh Rupees towards '*Suvarna Siddheshwar*' project, decorating the Temple and its surrounding Deity, *Lord Siddheshwara*, religious centre for thousand years. The staff and the students donate towards *Flag-Day* and *National Disaster Funds* every year. The Latrine Scheme of Central government, which was implemented by Solapur Municipal Corporation, was a failure due to large scale corruption involved in it. 14 students of Sociology department along with Head of the Department as their guide conducted a detailed survey of the 1013 households which were provided with the facility of Latrine. The survey made by our students in December 2013, helped the government to verify the facts and make necessary arrangements to improve the conditions of the scheme.

The survey of Ramai Household Project, the scheme of houses for Scheduled Caste community, was conducted by the students of Sociology department under the aegis of Solapur Municipal Corporation. It was the survey of 821 families. It helped Municipal Corporation to implement the scheme effectively.
