## Annual Report of Controller of Examinations – 2023-24

Sangameshwar College, Solapur, an autonomous college affiliated with PAH Solapur University, Solapur, and accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with Grade 'A', continues to implement the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) to provide a distinctive and comprehensive learning experience to its students.

The Examination Section's primary responsibility is to conduct examinations in a transparent, fair, and organized manner as guided by the Controller of Examinations. During the academic year 2023-24, the Office of the Controller of Examinations ensured meticulous planning and execution of all examination-related activities, including the following:

- **Question Paper Management:** Secure receipt and storage of question papers from subject experts.
- **Examination Schedule:** Preparation of detailed timetables and smooth execution of Semester End Examinations.
- **Seating Arrangements:** Implementation of organized seating plans to maintain decorum during examinations.
- **Central Evaluation:** Timely evaluation of answer scripts through the central evaluation process.
- **Result Declaration:** Publishing results promptly on the Sangameshwar College website after due approval by the Principal or Chief Controller of Examinations in alignment with PAH Solapur University policies.

Students were provided with the facility to apply for revaluation after receiving their results. The process was further streamlined by offering easy access to photocopies of their evaluated answer scripts, ensuring transparency and accountability.

### Integration of NEP 2020

In line with the transformative vision of the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**, Sangameshwar College has taken proactive steps to integrate NEP 2020 into its examination and academic framework. The Examination Section adopted innovative practices to support the flexible and multidisciplinary learning pathways encouraged by NEP 2020. Key initiatives include:

The college followed to the revised marking pattern **60:40** for theory and **50:50** practical for both undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate (PG) programs, maintaining consistency in assessment methods.

6. Total Number of Final Year students Appeared 1262 and Total Number of Students 993.

## IT Integration Report

Academic Year - 2023-24

The integration of IT and reforms in examination procedures, including Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA), continues to significantly enhance the Examination Management System (EMS) of our institution. During this academic year, examinations were conducted offline for first, second, and third-year undergraduate courses, as well as first and second-year postgraduate courses. Odd semester examinations took place in Nov 2023, and even semester examinations were held in March 2024. The institution followed to the revised marking pattern of 60:40 for theory and 50:50 for practical assessments, as per the statute accepted and approved by the Governing Body and Academic Annual Quality Assurance Report of Sangameshwar College, Solapur.

The centralised examination unit of the institute organized examinations for 60% of the marks under the title SEE (Semester End Examination), while the remaining 40% marks, known as Continuous Assessment (CA), were conducted by individual departments. Departments scheduled tests for respective courses and utilized platforms such as Google Forms and the institution's internal portal for online continuous assessment (CA) examinations.

### Key Enhancements and Integrations:

#### 1. Enhanced IT Infrastructure:

- Deployment of upgraded servers for CIMS Master Soft ERP Solutions Pvt. Ltd. to ensure faster and smoother operations during peak periods like result processing and timetable generation.
- Introduction of a mobile-friendly portal for students to access examination schedules, results, and grievances.

#### 2. Automated Practical Assessment:

- Practical assessments now adhere to a 50:50 pattern, with 50% marks allocated to external examination (SEE) and 50% to internal continuous assessment.

#### 3. Improved Grievance Redressal:

- The Examination Grievance Redressal Cell now accepts online grievances through the ERP system.

#### 4. Advanced Data Analytics for Results:

- Integration of AI-powered analytics in result analysis to identify trends in student performance, providing actionable insights for curriculum development.

#### 5. Introduction of Digital OMR Processing:

- Enhanced the processing of OMR sheets for the compulsory first & Second year NEP 2020 undergraduate subject which has Co-curricular Courses (CC) Results are generated seamlessly through advanced OMR checker software with additional features for error detection and correction.

#### 6. Faculty Training:

- Regular training sessions for faculty on IT tools and software used for examination management, ensuring efficient and error-free operations.

The institution remains committed to automating and refining all examination-related processes through IT integration. These advancements contribute to a robust, transparent, and student-friendly examination ecosystem, supporting the overall mission of quality education at Sangameshwar College, Solapur.
