

 - (b) Participation and organization of workshops etc.
- 2. The initiation of any particular field visit or activity will be proceeded by prior discussion and agreed upon in writing by appropriate responsible representatives of both institutions.
- 3. Both the parties shall come to the institution on their own expenditure to interact or to use the facilities present: Of course, with prior permission and on the surety that it will not cause any harm to the facility.
- 4. Day to day implementation of this agreement will be coordinated by Principal, Government Industrial Training Institute, Vijapur Road, Solapur and Dept. of Physics & Chemistry Sangameshwar Autonomous College, Solapur.
- 5. Amendments to this MoU may be made at any time after constitution and agreement between the two institutions. Any such amendment must by in writing and signed by both parties.
- 6. This MoU will remain in force for a period of five (b) years from the date it is fully executed. 




