

# **Student Satisfaction Survey report 2023-24**

The institution with greater vision to spread education in general and to instruct in any branch of knowledge wherever and whenever feasible. The institution has provided the suitable environment for students to develop their creativity, intellectual capabilities. The ultimate objective is to develop all round personality. The institution provides worldclass infrastructure that support learning environment.

Any improvement in the process depends on analysis of reliable feedback. IQAC used Master Soft ERP to collect feedback on as questionaries given for SSS by NAAC under SSS guidelines. The objective was to meet the vision, mission and institutional goals through collecting reliable, exact and appropriate feedback on institutional facilities. The link for questionaries and manual to provide feedback was shared with students through WhatsApp group notifications of concerned departments and collected the responses along with suggestions of students. 1264 students had given feedback on questionaries of SSS. The response of students on SSS was shared with concerned authorities or HODs of concerned department. The data was analysed and discussed with concerned authorities through IQAC. Feedback system helped IQAC to rectify the errors, technical problems and sustain quality in education.

Students were invited to participate in SSS survey from all four faculty that is faculty of Arts, Science, Commerce and Professional Courses and Management Sciences. 176 students from Arts faculty, 134 students from Science faculty, 471 students from Commerce and 483 students from Professional Courses and Management Sciences participated. The specific programme wise details of student's participation is as shown in following table.







Commerce faculty students contributed 27% of responses to feedback questionary, 95% from second year and 05% from final year PG students responded to feedback
















Table: Response of students for fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.


























